

## **AIRGAS Deliveries during the Covid-19 conditions:**

When will Airgas deliver to each building (days, time frame)?

*Starting next week Tuesday, March 31st, Airgas will begin deliveries to campus on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8am EST to 11am EST. Airgas will use their normal cylinder drivers: Phil Egert and Andy Gillespie, both of whom have Notre Dame access cards. The drivers will also be informed to swing by campus on Fridays as well if necessary to pick up any empty liquid dewar cans that may be empty from areas that we can access without help from the Notre Dame personnel. Please keep in mind this schedule may have to be altered in the future depending on any issues that may arise due to the limited space on the trucks or emergency cylinder requirements (which should be limited due to slower than normal research). Bulk Nitrogen vessel deliveries to the four (4) locations on campus will remain being filled on an "as needed" basis depending on the automated telemetry monitoring system. Airgas is still experiencing multiple orders of liquid nitrogen dewars being requested simply because labs are afraid of the unknown. Once upper management personnel at the University sends out a notification informing every one of the dedicated delivery schedule this may help limit some of these orders. For the time being Airgas will be delivering what they can and hopefully end users will continue to give back empty cans so that we can turn those around and get them re-filled and delivered back to campus.*
